

CLEARVIEW SWIM & HEALTH CLUB RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all individuals. These rules have been established to assure safe and sanitary operation of the pool facilities. Parents are requested to caution their children to observe all rules and obey instructions of the pool manager and other employees. Any failure to comply with these rules shall be considered sufficient cause for termination of non-refundable membership.

POOL HOURS

1. Daily 12:00 pm – 8:00 pm

NOTE: These times are subject to the discretion of the pool manager and change.

2. Monday through Friday is reserved for Swim Team practice between the hours of 10:00 am and 12:00 pm
3. Only Members in good standing are permitted into the pool area following the proper sign-in procedure.
4. For health and safety purposes, all members and guests shall observe the following:
 - A. No glass containers of any kind are permitted in the pool area.
 - B. No running, pushing, wrestling or any undue disturbance is permitted
 - C. No pets area allowed within the pool area.
 - D. Admission shall be refused to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, infections, or wearing bandages.
 - E. Expectorating in the pool or on the ground or blowing of one's nose into the pool is prohibited.
 - F. Swimmers are not permitted in the baby pool at any time unless they are caring for the non-swimmer.
 - G. No gum is permitted on pool grounds.
 - H. Paper wrappers of any kind and garbage are to be placed into garbage containers. Soda cans or any aluminum containers are to be placed in the recycling containers.
 - I. Non-swimmers are not permitted in water over their head.
 - J. No one under the age of 18 will be permitted in the pool when it is adult swim. Exception to this will be children (under the age of 6) being held by the parent during adult swim.

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5. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. The Club is not responsible for any accident or injury in connection with such use.
6. Parents are responsible for the supervision of children who are non-swimmers in the baby pool as well as in all other parts of the pool area.
7. The cost of any damage to pool property will be charged to the responsible member.
8. **Chairs are for adults only until 4:00 pm. An adult is defined as any person over the age of 18. However, adults will always have first right to chairs on crowded days at any time.**
9. Abusive language or indecent acts will not be tolerated.
10. Members shall drive slowly and carefully on driveway and in parking lot.
11. Martin and Goodnow Streets are not to be used for parking.
12. The Club is not responsible for loss or damage to personal property.
13. **No floating pool equipment (i.e. rafts, noodles, inner tubes, etc.) will be permitted except in the wading pool. The ONLY exception to this rule is swimees or T-shirt float ring when the parent is in the water with the non-swimmer.**

RULES RELATED TO DIVING

1. Only one (1) person at a time is permitted on the diving board. This also means that no one is permitted on the steps.
2. Each diver entering the pool must make sure the area is clear of swimmer's before entering the water.
3. Swimming directly beneath the board is prohibited.
4. Excessive bounding is prohibited.
5. Children wearing swimees are not permitted to go off the diving board unless they are accompanied by an adult.

GUESTS

1. Each family is permitted unlimited number of guests.
2. Guests are the responsibility of the member that brought them.
3. An admission fee of \$4.00 per person is the guest charge. And \$2.00 after 4:00 pm.
4. No guest is permitted more than six (6) times per season.
5. House guests of pool members should contact the manager for guest rate.

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LIFEGUARDS AND MANAGER

1. The lifeguards have the authority to recommend to the manager the expulsion from the pool and to give penalties to anyone who fails to cooperate in maintaining safety decorum. This includes running, tag, pushing, jumping, wrestling, ball playing, etc., in or around the pool area. Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in the following disciplinary actions:
 - A. First Offense: Warning
 - B. Second Offense: Loss of fifteen (15) minutes of swimming time (benched)
 - C. Third Offense: Must leave the pool and pool area for the day and the parent is to contact the pool manager before returning.
2. Members and guests are to stay clear of the lifeguard stand and are not to distract (talk to) the lifeguard from his/her duties. Any guard caught breaking this rule shall be handled by the manager.
3. The Pool Manager shall set the radio station to be played at the pool.
4. The Pool Manager is required to enforce these rules and regulations. He/She is permitted to restrict any member from use of the pool for any infraction of these rules.
5. The Pool Manager is hereby given authorization to act in the interest of the pool and members in the areas where no rules are spelled out.
6. Length of adult swim versus regular swim is subject to change on hot days or crowded conditions.
7. Failure to comply with any of these rules and regulations will be cause for the manager to suspend the member from the pool and pool area until the case is reviewed by the Board of Directors.
8. These rules and regulations may be revised at any time, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors.
